

Archbishop Quigley - 3-on-3 Basketball Tournament

Tournament Rules

- 1) All participants must be entered on the enclosed registration sheet. Teams are limited to four players per team. One player will be designated the "Team Captain" and will be the team representative.
- 2) All Participants must be enrolled in seventh or eighth grade to participate in the tournament. All participants must be from the parish grammar school or parish religious education program.
- 3) Due to gym availability, schools are allowed only 1 team per school to participate in the tournament.
- 4) Registration Forms must be faxed or postmarked by Oct 14 for \$10 fee or by Oct 17 for \$20 fee.
- 5) All participants must also have a signed permission slip turned in the day of the tournament.
- 6) Teams must be accompanied by an adult who will stay at the gym during the tournament.
- 7) Spectators are to remain in the stands at all times during games. Walking on the courts will not be allowed for any reason.
- 8) **Unsportsmanlike conduct will NOT be tolerated by spectators or players. Individual violators will be subject to ejection from the gymnasium and tournament. Teams violating this rule will forfeit their tournament games.**
- 9) Players should come prepared to play. Gym shoes are required.
- 10) Archbishop Quigley's coaches and/or basketball team members will officiate the games. All decisions are final. Please respect these decisions. This tournament is for the participants to have fun and enjoy themselves. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- 11) Games will be played half court.
- 12) Games will be to **15** points or a **fifteen-minute time limit**. (Running Clock)
- 13) Clock will stop in the final minute on dead ball situations or fouls.
- 14) Rules will be governed by the **Official IHSA Rules** .
- 15) Substitutions may be made on dead ball situations.
- 16) After a foul is committed, the ball will be put in play from the top of the key. With the 7th team foul, one free throw, worth **(1)** point, will be awarded for each foul (*note change*). Individual fouls will be counted. 5 fouls will result in foul-out.
- 17) After a rebound by the defense or change of possession, the ball must be taken past the 3 point line. All three points (both feet and ball) must be behind the line, before being put into play.
- 18) All baskets will be worth one **(1)** point. **3** point shots will be worth **2** points.
- 19) Each game will start with a coin toss to determine first possession. Alternate Possession will determine jump balls.
- 20) Substitutions will be allowed during the game. Subs must be made on dead ball situations.
- 21) Each team is allowed two 30 second time-outs per game. Clock will stop. One additional 30 second time-out for overtime.
- 22) In the event of a tie score after normal play, each overtime will be one minute in length.
- 23) Teams will be randomly assigned in a ladder. Winning teams will advance in the Championship bracket. Any team suffering its first loss will be moved to the Consolation bracket. A second loss will eliminate the team from competition. All teams will play at least 2 games.
- 24) In the event a team arrives late for competition, the Tournament Director will decide if the team may have to forfeit a game or be disqualified from competition.

Individual trophies will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams. Top 3 teams will also be presented with a Tournament Plaque to be given to their school. All athletes will receive a Certificate of Participation and a 3-on-3 Quigley Basketball T-Shirt.
